## 37th Annual R. O. C. Pre-Entry is Open Until October 4th

*As we have stated, those of you that were entered for the March* are already pre-entered for the 2020 Race of Champions. Just remember you need to bring your pass from March and exchange it for the current October ROC pass. If you had rented a garage in March and wish to use it for October, please email Chris Middleton at [chris@ccsracing.us](mailto:chris@ccsracing.us) and confirm that.

*For those of you looking to rent a garage*, please submit the form to Chris ASAP so we can put you in line to get garages as 200 competitors cancel their units.

*Please notify us what region* you would like to be ranked from for your grid position. If you fail to notify us, we will use the region from your license to place you on the grid.

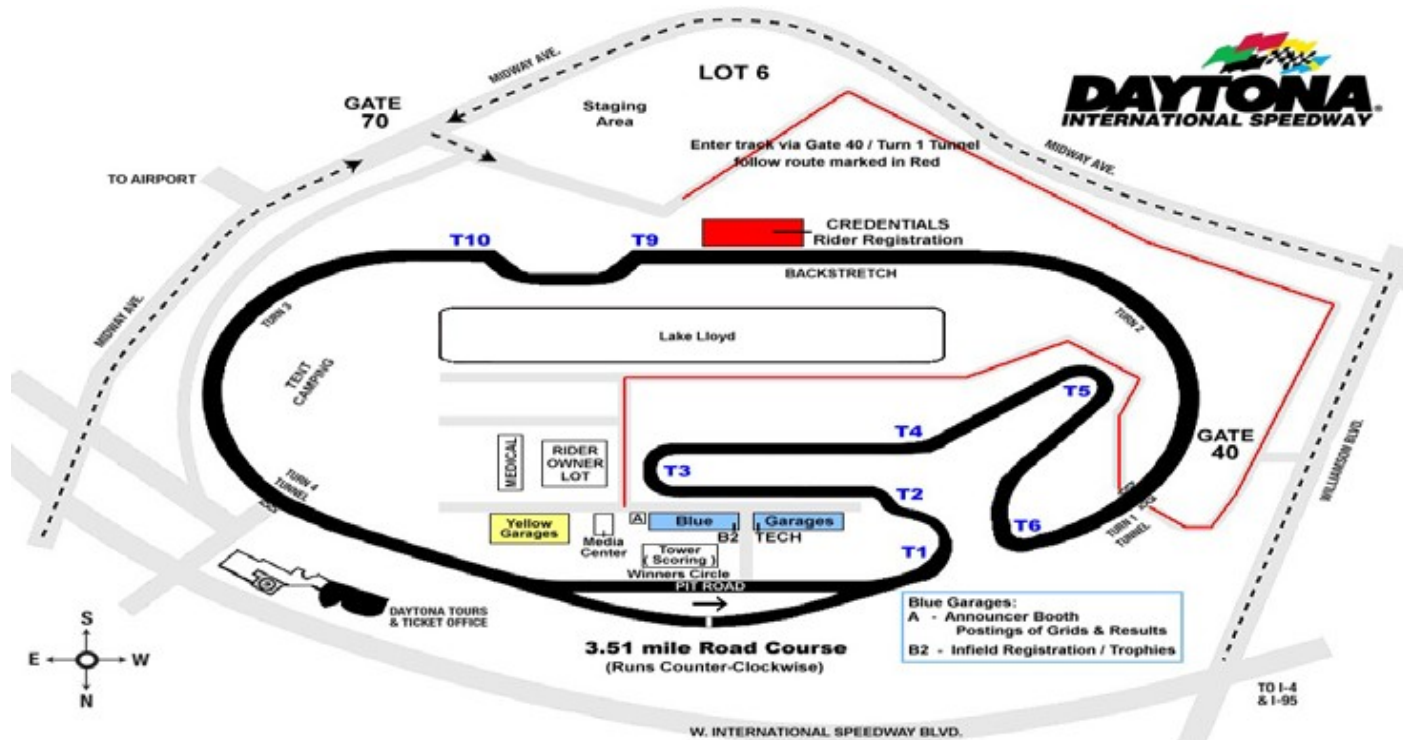
*Rider/Owner Lot camping* is only available to registered riders limited to one space per rider. See page 5 for info and the form to reserve a space. (Limited to 70 spaces.)

## Registration Area and Track Entrance Through Gate 70 Off Midway Ave

Since it has worked well in the past during the Race of Champions, Daytona has asked us to continue to stage by the Backstretch Ticket Booth off of Midway Ave through Gate 70. (Following the light blue path to the Staging Area.) Once in the lot you will be instructed to park and take the very short walk over to the Backstretch Registration Building to get your paperwork and credentials for the event.

Once properly credentialed on Friday, you will be allowed to follow the service road (the red colored path) around to the Turn 1 Tunnel and then into the facility. *(For those with Rider/Owner reservations you may enter and set up on Friday once you are properly credentialed when the garages open at 10:00am on Friday.)*

For those who have their credentials, you will be allowed to use Gate 40 off Williamson after 10:00am on Friday to enter the facility, Please follow these simple directions and enjoy the 37th Race of Champions at Daytona International Speedway!



**Age Restrictions:** You must be at least 16 years of age to race at Daytona except the following: Minors between the ages of 14 and 16 are limited to Moto 3, 300 SuperSport, 300 SuperBike, 500 GT, 500 SuperSport, 500 SuperBike and ASRA Moto 3

**Fees:** The 2020 pre-entry fees for the Race of Champions at Daytona are **\$135** for the first CCS class, and **\$95** for each additional CCS class. And as in previous years, pre-entry fees include your full-event gate pass, a **\$65** value. The only exception to this are the ASRA races, (Moto 3, ThunderBike, SuperStock and SportBike). Those will be the **\$95** pre-entry fee as a National sprint class and will **not** include your gate pass. Post entry fees for races that have not reached 80 machines on the grid are now **\$100** for each CCS class and they do not include your gate pass, which will cost you **\$60** for those signing in on Friday, **\$50** for those signing in on Saturday, and **\$25** for those who come on Sunday morning. All ASRA classes will be their standard post-entry fee of **\$100** for Moto 3, ThunderBike, Superstock and SportBike.

**CCS Gridding:** 2019 Expert National Champions who pre-enter will be given Pole Position. The remaining pre-entered riders

for the Race of Champions will be gridded by regional ranking as of **October 4, 2020**, with the riders leading the points in their respective regions on the cut-off date placed on the grid first, then all the riders who are ranked second placed on the grid behind them, and so on until all riders who have scored points are on the grid by their ranking. Riders who do not have any regional ranking will be placed at the back of the pre-entered riders with points by order of entry. All post entrants will be placed on the grids

by order of entry.

**ASRA Gridding:** While the ASRA classes will pay points towards the 2020 National Championship, all those classes will be gridded by qualifying sessions Saturday morning. All pre-entries for Daytona must be received by **October 4, 2020** at 5PM. Any entries received after that date and time are subject to return without processing. Please return them in enough time to allow for delivery delays. Due to our agreement with Daytona, there will be no cancellations or refunds allowed after the **October 4, 2019** pre-entry deadline. All entries or cancellations must be received in the Fort Worth office by that date.

**Garage Rentals:** For those teams who would like a garage for the event, the fees are **\$300** for the roll-down units, (no interior walls), and **\$150** for the open-air spaces. Riders who have rented garages will be entitled to that unit and are welcome to put as many people as will fit into their space without causing a problem with your neighbors in the garages next to you. If there is a problem, we will remove all but the rider that originally rented the unit and his machines. **Garage rental from must be**

**CCS Classic:** We will be running all CCS Classic classes to include some vintage machines since ARHMA has dropped the October event. These will be National Championship races. Read the Addendum in the 2020

Rule Book for complete rules.

**MotoGirlGT:** These classes will be run as points classes, as part of their 2020 National Championship.

**General move-in:** Move-in will commence on Friday (Starting at 10:00am) Paddock space will be on a first come-first served basis and riders will be allowed into the paddock on Friday after getting their credentials. Please be patient, we will try to get everyone in the facility if possible during the afternoon and the final group will be allowed in at 4:30 PM when the ASRA/CCS Registration ends. In all cases, we must leave the paddock by 5:30 PM Friday.

To gain access to the paddock you must have an event credential from ASRA/CCS so make sure you visit registration before moving your vehicle into line.

Post-entry gate passes will cost you **\$60** for those signing in on Friday, **\$50** for those signing in on Saturday and **\$25** for those who come in on Sunday morning so please be prepared.

**Event Shirts:** A limited number of event shirts will be available at \$20 per shirt by registered entrants.

**Racer Camping:** Go to page 5 for complete information. **Camping form must be returned to Chris at ASRA/CCS office by October 4**

**Daytona Pre-Entry Cut-Off October 4, 2020 at 5:00pm. There will be no refunds after October 8, 2020.**

**1. Rider Information Section:** Fill in your 2020 Competition # and check either Amateur or Expert. Print your personal information. Give us the emergency contact information we need. **You must be at least 16 years of age to race at Daytona except the following: Minors between the ages of 14 and 16 are limited to Moto 3, 300 SuperBike, 300 SuperSport, 500 GT, 500 SuperSport, 500 SuperBike and ASRA Moto 3**

**2. Class Section:** To enter a class, print the brand of motorcycle (Yamaha, Kawasaki, Aprilia, Etc.) in the BRAND column next to each class that you are entering, then print the displacement in the CC column. Classic and MotoGirlGT please use standard forms from the CCSRacing.us website.

**3; Region Selection:** Please circle the region you would like to be ranked from. If you do not circle a region, we will take a ranking from your home region (the one you are licensed in). You will be placed on the grid by these rankings as of the cut-off date, October 4, 2020, if you have no points in the region you circled, you will be placed on the grid by order of entry.

**3. Fees:** Daytona Pre-Entry fees are **\$135.00** for the first class entered for the Race of Champions, **\$95.00** for each additional class entered All ASRA classes are **\$95.00** pre-entry. Checks on US banks should be for the full amount calculated as above. Canadian or other international riders must remit by either charge card or cashiers check or money order in US funds. ## ASRA Team Challenge Pre-Entry Information and Instructions Daytona International Speedway - October 17, 2020

**Please print all information- clearly, carefully, and legibly.** If we cannot decipher your information with some degree of confidence, we will return the entry for clarification.

**1. Team Captain Information Section:** Fill in your Team Challenge #, AMA Membership #, expiration date and your 2019 CCS Competition # Team Captain must have a current CCS license and current AMA Membership to enter a team in the event.

**2. Class Section:** To enter a class, print the brand of motorcycle (Yamaha, Kawasaki, Aprilia, Etc.) in the BRAND column next to the one class that you are entering, then print the displacement in the CC column.

**3. MyLaps Transponder:** Team Challenge events are now scored using the MyLaps Transponder units so a MyLaps Transponder is required. If you do not have a MyLaps Transponder, they will be available for rent at \$30 for the race.

**4. Fees:** Team Challenge Pre-Entry fees are \$200 for the each class entered. Checks on US banks should be for the full amount calculated as above. Canadian or other international riders must remit by either charge card or cashiers check or money order in US funds. All checks or money orders should be payable to CCS or ASRA. **(Post entry will be \$225 at the track.)**

**MasterCard/Visa/Discover:** Please fill in the blanks on the front of the form. Check off the correct card type (MasterCard, Visa, or Discover). We must have the expiration date, complete card number, CVN number, zip code from the billing address and name as printed on the card. Declined charges will result in a return of the entry form without processing. Declined charges void original delivery date; entry will be processed as of the date payment is made on resubmitted pre-entries. All pre-entry fees will be charged immediately upon receipt, no exceptions.

Through a special arrangement with DIS, ASRA/CCS has obtained permission to use 70 spaces in the Rider / Owner Lot for Friday through Monday at 10am.

The Rider/Owner lot, located south of the yellow garage area, will be available for competitor RV parking for \$150 per site. Parking in this area will be limited to registered riders only. **(There can only be one request per registered rider! No Exceptions!!!)** There will not be any other camping available in the infield EXCEPT the R/O Lot.

### 37th Annual CCS R. O. C. Number Regulations

As the season has progressed, **once again** we have seen more and more “stylized” numbers and numbers with highlights around the numbers. These numbers are specifically not allowed by the 2020 Road Race Rules and Regulations. If you have these numbers on your bike when you come to tech at the Race of Champions, you will be turned away without a tech sticker for the event.

5.3.6 Numbers must be black and approximately 6” high and 1” wide, of standard block lettering with no shading, outlining or serifs. Number must be spaced approximately 1” from each other as well as the edge of the plate or display area. 6” or 4” numbers may be used on the rear plates as long as the number is clearly visible at speed. All numbers on any display must be the same size.

5.3.7 The following samples show the type style required to comply with these rules:

**1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 0**

5.3.8 Number plates must be free from any stickers or sponsorship logos except as required by specific class rules.

5.3.9 Final approval of non-compliant number display will rest with the Race Director or Referee.

### *AMA Membership Required For Race of Champions Entry*

*All ASRA/CCS combined events will require the racer have an AMA membership. This will allow ASRA/CCS riders to qualify for Moto America licenses easier along with reducing the Moto America practice ban to 7 days instead of the current 30 days for non AMA sanctioned events. AMA 1-event memberships are available but if you are attending more than one ASRA/CCS event a full membership is encouraged.*

### *Rules Committee Suggestions Open Through October 30th*

It’s that time again, time for you to submit your rules change suggestions for the Rules Committee to consider for inclusion in the 2021 rule book. The Committee is comprised of several racers, officials and technical consultants, and every suggestion is reviewed from all aspects by each group before being voted on and passed on to the President of ASRA/CCS, Kevin Elliott, for final approval on November 15th, 2020. To insure adequate time to discuss your suggestions, all input should be received in Fort Worth by October 30, 2020.

At this time we have very few requests for changes to the rules for 2021 so please do not hesitate to send

your requests into the office as soon as you can.

Remember, the 2020 Rules Committee is authorized to consider any recommendation submitted by a licensed racer with ASRA/CCS, so that means you should let them hear your opinion on the items printed here or anything that you believe they should discuss before making their final recommendations on November 16th.
