

Proper Mounting and Activation of Westhold Activated Transponder

1. Transmitter should be mounted in a vertical upright position, (label right side up so you can read it), this is absolute regardless of location mounted
2. The location selected should allow racer to observe lights enclosed in top of unit. (It is the riders responsibility to confirm activation before entering race track.)
3. Preferred mounting location is on the outer edge of right fork leg by use of double sided foam tape and good quality zip tie or other mechanical fastener
 - 3.1 Alternate mounting locations can be used on fairing, brake caliper brackets, triple clamps, front fender, etc but should not interfere with normal operation of motorcycle and must be approved by tech. Solid metal or carbon fiber WILL interfere with operation of the transponder, there should be a clear path from the bottom of the unit to the ground free of these materials.
4. When passing an activation loop the green light on the top of the unit will flash rapidly, then after leaving the activation area, the green light will continue to blink at a slow steady pace.
 - 4.1 A red light indicates a low battery or possible other issue; please see tech for assistance.
5. Activation loops will be set up at pit out and whenever possible in Tech Inspection to insure units are working. Riders may use either location prior to entering the race track for practice or race.
6. Sprint units (standard) will turn on for approximately 60 minutes following an activation; expected life is 3 years with standard use.
7. Endurance units (extended; Team Challenge) will turn on for approximately 150 minutes following an activation; expected life in Team Challenge use is 2 years.

Remember Your Transponder Number

Your transponder number(s) must be written on each and every entry form (post and pre-entry) for CCS/ASRA races so that Scoring can verify as well as track your race position and laptimes.

Our Clerks will ask you for the number(s) during registration and cannot process your paperwork without it.

Suggestion: Write your transponder number(s) with a sharpie on the back of your CCS/ASRA License card. Or make a record of it in your mobile device.
