ASRA Team Challenge Opener at Homestead-Miami Speedway on February 12-13

The American Sportbike Racing Association would like to announce that the first round of the Team Challenge Championship will be at Homestead Miami Speedway for 2022. The AMA Sanctioned ASRA Team Challenge Series will have a 8 race national championship giving all ASRA/CCS licensed riders an opportunity to try racing under a different format from the traditional CCS Sportsman events.

The ASRA Team Challenge Series will still have four classes, GTL, GTU, GTO and Overall. ASRA will continue to support each

class with cash contingency as well as support from a myriad of returning contingency sponsors for each class.

The 2022 ASRA Series will kick off at Homestead Miami Speedway on February 12-13 with the ASRA Team Challenge on Saturday.

So join us at Homestead Miami Speedway in Homestead FL for a great way to kick off the 2022 ASRA Team Challenge Series and the ASRA/Championship Cup Series Florida Sprints on February 12-13. You'll be glad you did!

Updated Registration Process for 2022

In response to numerous requests/observations we will be continuing the way we handled pre-entered riders in registration for 2021.

First we are still working with our insurance company on the implementation of electronic releases and their validity in all situations from licensing to entry and state requirements for Releases and Assumption of risk for participants, but as of yet, they still require a wet signature on race weekends. (Not to say it won't change, and we are pushing for it, but not yet.)

Our biggest hold up at registration for pre-entered riders is transponder rentals/assignments. While the rider in the past would hold up the "Pre-entry No Changes" line renting a transponder in 2021, we will stop that in 2022 by making the "Pre-entry No Changes" line exclusively for those who own a transponder that is listed in their Portal profile and therefore already in our database. That

way you simply need to show your license and ID, then sign the green copy release and be on your way

For 2022 the "Pre-entry with changes" line will be for those riders who need to rent a transponder, add or delete classes or any other time-consuming activity after they have already pre-entered the event on the portal.

After much discussion with those who would have to work tech, the decision was made to NOT move pre-entries into tech since all that would do is move the "road-block" from pre-entry registration to the tech garage.

Please keep in mind this is just a step to try to address your concerns over the lines and wait times. If this does not work to our, or your, satisfaction we will continue to try to address the situation to the best of our ability.

Reminder on Transponders for 2022

Since the Westhold activated transponders are no longer available, we would like to remind you that it is your responsibility to activate your transponder if that is the type unit you are using before entering the track for practice or races. We will no longer have the activation mat at pit out, There will be an activator in Tech ONLY.

If your transponder fails to activate, you will have to rent a transponder at registration. If you fail to do this, you will not be scored, and nobody wants that to happen. We will no longer offer loaners in 2022. So please go to Tech and check for the activation light (multiple

Flashes) on the top of your unit while going through activation area. And if there is a problem, ask for help immediately.

For those of you who want to skip the activation step, we have rechargeable transponders available for \$225, a \$25 savings from suggested retail.

For those in the Team Challenge, you will still be required to rent or own a Westhold Hard-wired or G3 rechargeable transponder for 2022 events.

ASRA Contingency

The greatest feature of this ASRA contingency is how easy it is to qualify for the reward. Simply fill out your contingency form and have the technical inspector verify you have the correct AMA and ASRA Series stickers displayed on both sides of the machine used in the eligible class. That's it, that's all you have to do.

ASRA Contingency Requirements:

All machines must display an approved AMA and ASRA Series sticker on both sides of the machine. A completed ASRA contingency form must be presented, with each motorcycle, at tech inspection for official verification. All forms must be presented and signed at tech inspection with the motorcycle before racing starts. To officially be considered a finisher, you must meet the requirements found in 3.4.7 with regard to placement on the results.

ASRA Contingency Restrictions: ASRA Contingency rewards are scheduled to be processed and mailed out within 45 days of the event, so if you have not received your award by 60 days after the event, contact the ASRA/CCS office at 817-246-1127 or email Eric Kelcher at contingency@ccsracing.us. Inquiries made later than 75 days past the event will not be accepted.

- 1. Please print the information** in the blank spaces provided. It is important that you print clearly and precisely as most of the errors are not "typo" problems, but the results of our inability to read the forms. Do not abbreviate city names.
- 2. Make sure we have complete** personal information including name, address, ASRA/CCS member number (new riders with ASRA/CCS please leave this blank), day and night time phone numbers, e-mail address, birth date, and age. (Applicants under the age of 18 must have a signed notarized release form from their parent or legal guardian along with an original signed application on file with ASRA/CCS before a competition license will be issued.) Applicant must be a minimum of 14 years old to apply for an ASRA Series license. Applicant must be a minimum of 12 years old to apply for a Championship Cup Series license and those who are between the ages of 12 and 16 may have their license restricted to use in certain classes.
- 3. Renewal applications** please give us your 7 digit ASRA/CCS member number. New applicant please leave this blank, your member number will be assigned during initial processing. The personal insurance information is required.
- 4. Give us the correct information** for the type of License for which you are applying. Please check Amateur or Expert, and then fill out the CCS required information. If you are applying for an ASRA License, please check the appropriate box. ASRA License requires a current AMA Membership. Current AMA Memberships are also required at all ASRA/CCS crossover events in 2022.

1. Rider Information Section: Fill in your Member # if known, your 2022 Competition #, and check either Amateur or Expert. Print your personal information. Give us the emergency contact information we need. Please make certain to include your Westhold Transponder number if available.

2. Class Section: To enter a class, print the brand and model of motorcycle (Yamaha R-1, Kawasaki ZX10, Suzuki GSXR, Etc.) in the BRAND/MODEL column next to each class that you are entering, and then print the displacement in the CC column. To enter the Rookies Cup Challenge check the box beside your class. **For Classic please use the separate Classic form from the CCSRacing.us website.** If you are also entering additional classes on the standard form, please mark the Classic/Vintage form as "add-on" in the box provided. **If you are entering CCS or ASRA classes on an ASRA weekend you must enter your AMA membership number on the entry form.**

3. Race 1 or Race 2 Selection: These boxes are only used for CCS Twin Sprint entries, Race 1 is Saturday and Race 2 is Sunday. If the race only runs once on the weekend (I.E. Rookies Cup, GT classes), enter Race 1 please. As of November 1, 2021, these events are: Carolina Motorsports Park, Summit Point in June, all Blackhawk Farms in 2022, NCBike in July, Roebing Road in July and August and the September event at NJMP. If you do not check these boxes, we will automatically enter you in Race 1 only.

4. Fees: Pre-Entry fees are \$90.00 for the first CCS class entered and \$70.00 for each additional CCS class entered. All events at NJMP are \$100 for the first pre-entry and includes electricity and camping. All events at Summit are \$100 for the first pre-entry and includes the security required for camping. All ASRA classes are \$100.00 pre-entry. **Practice pre-entry** is \$175 for those events with an ASRA/CCS hosted practice before the event and counts as a first entry for the event. (These events are: Autobahn in April and August, Summit Point in May, Blackhawk Farms in May.) **Daytona Biketoberfest** pre-entry prices are **\$150 for your first CCS entry**, each additional class is \$100. As in the past, the first CCS pre-entry includes your Hot Pit Credential, a \$65 value. For those who choose to post enter the event, it will be \$125 per class plus you will have to purchase a credential.

Checks on US banks should be for the full amount calculated as above. Canadian or other international riders must remit by either charge card, cashiers check or money order in US funds. All checks or money orders should be payable to CCS or ASRA.

Master Card/Visa/Discover: Please fill in the blanks at the bottom of the page on the front of this form. Check off the correct card type (Master Card, Visa, or Discover). We must have the **billing zip code, expiration date, CVN number, complete card number and name** as printed on the card. Declined charges will result in a return of the entry form without processing to the rider.
